Main Page opens on Start, with loaded image and 3 buttons, "Schedule", "Calendar" and "Template"	Met 	Client suggested more colour.
Once "Schedule" is clicked, it opens a grid of 4x5 buttons to correspond to a lesson schedule.	Met 	Client identified the schedule, appreciated how specifically tailored it was.
Planner page opens without complications, with all editable text fields and 3 buttons, "Save", "Clear" and "Load".	Met 	Client noticed lesson plan details we discussed during client consultation. Client suggested a functionality for inserting hyperlinks, for online resources.

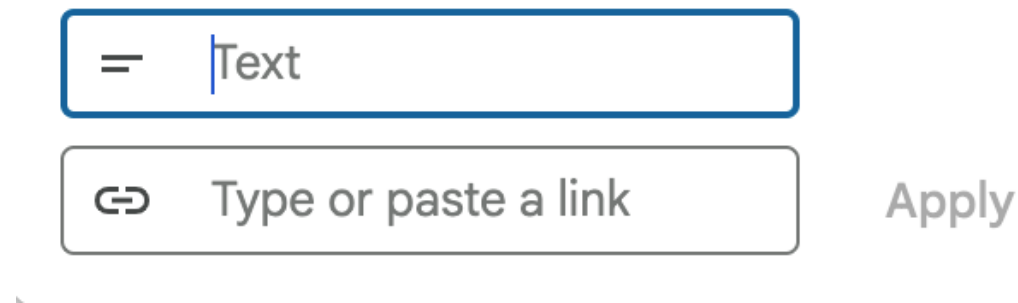
Success Criteria	Met?	Client Feedback
Clicking “Templates” from the Main page will open a Planner page without “Clear” button. An additional text field will also appear called “file name”	Met 	Client was a little confused about what “File name” meant.
Saving templates will save the .txt file in an accessible directory, using the specified file name identifies the file.	Met. All templates viewable in “templates” folder.	Client suggested an option to preview all saved templates.
When “Calendar” is clicked from the Main page, it opens a Calendar with drop down options for Year and Month.	Met: 	Client found the Calendar easy to use
Clicking a day from the Calendar will open options for periods, which open a Planner page when clicked.	Met. Planner Page opens from DayFrame.	Found it difficult to see what day they created a plan for.

Further development:

Aesthetic improvements: More images, colour, perhaps tweaking the arrangement of components to make more symmetrical (Save and Clear buttons are not even on Template page).

Create a button to view all Saved templates. This could even reuse the code to open the FileChooser but instead does not require pressing load button. Could be accessed from Template page or Main page.

Adding a hyperlink compatibility so links can be clicked and opened. Below is a screenshot from Gmail's link option. A simple design like this might be ideal.



Differentiating days with saved plans for Schedule and Calendar: A customisable colour option, perhaps using JColorChooser or even implementing a colour wheel. Subject names edited in the Planner Page could also replace the name of the button (e.g. "Japanese"). This was something I actually planned to make but couldn't include in the final product.
